Compare ownership before features

System of record

Who holds and operates the authoritative accounting ledger?

Write surface

Can a platform create accounting records, not merely retrieve data?

Product surface

Are API, embedded UI, hosted UI, or bookkeeping services documented?

Controls

Are validation, permissions, audit history, reconciliation, or close controls documented?

Entity model

What is public for tenants, businesses, entities, and consolidation?

Agent access

Is MCP or another agent-facing product interface documented?

Buying path

Is access self-serve, publicly priced, partner-led, or sales-led?

Reading rule

Do not total the columns into a score. A finance-led multi-entity buyer, an SMB platform, and a product team embedding a governed ledger have different best-fit criteria.

Eight viable operating models

The useful question is which system should own the books, workflows, controls, and customer experience.

Not scored

Security certifications, geographic availability, detailed currency behavior, SLAs, migration scope, and implementation services require deeper diligence than a public-source landscape can support reliably.

Start with ownership

Embedded system of record

Choose this model when the product should own journals, reports, and the accounting experience for each customer.

Traditional integration

Choose this when customers already operate authoritative books elsewhere and continuity matters more than owning the ledger.

Custom build

Choose this only when accounting behavior is a durable differentiator and the organization can permanently fund correctness, controls, migrations, and reporting.

Proof design

Use the same business event, journal evidence, correction, report drilldown, permission boundary, and export across every shortlisted option.
